The Physical Security Project Manager will play an important and central role in implementing Danske Bank's workplace strategy and strategy for Physical security in corporate offices and branches. The Physical Security Project Manager will be responsible for identifying and scoping new security projects, ensuring that Danske Bank fulfill their strategy in the best possible way.

Main tasks include:

- Focus on developing the partnership with ISS and Group Physical Security and Risk (GPSR)
- Planning and designing the Physical Security programme and proactively monitoring its progress, resolving issues and initiating appropriate corrective action
- Ensuring the delivery of products is to the appropriate level of quality, reach the project target on time and within budget, in accordance with the programme plan and programme governance arrangements
- Reporting the progress of the programme at regular intervals to the Head of FSM
- Daily project management and overseeing Physical Security in Danske Bank in regards to tasks, milestones, contract budget in Denmark and the Nordic Region, and Baltics.
- Prioritizing daily operation tasks together with Group Physical Security and Risk in Danske Bank, ISS and Securitas
- Providing the right documentation and reporting on projects, incidents, compliance and daily operations.
- Serving COO and senior management positions with advice, analysis, both writing and giving presentations

- The ideal candidate has related physical security experience and a minimum of 5 years' experience working with project management from larger corporate offices, a leading consulting firm, or similar.
- Experience with project management principles as well as experience with producing PowerPoint presentations of a high quality and giving presentations at board/COO level.
- Experience in overseeing and developing areas of security. It is a plus if you have experience from international corporations and contexts although this is not essential.
- You are an excellent executer of techniques for planning, monitoring and controlling projects according to e.g. Prince 2 methods
- An academic background with a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Management, Engineering, Business, Architecture, Building Construction or Science, Security and Safety or a military background.
- High level of English, written and spoken.
